This is a starting point for a deeper relationship, both with the Day Care, and more importantly, with the kids.

I am grateful to all who come on Wednesdays to help and who can enjoy that fellowship we share as we work. Thank you to Brother Dan, who stepped in to close out our season, allowing these connections and relationships more time to bear fruit and to Mary Lowery who helps guide this ministry on the Advisory Board.

- **World Communion Sunday** (initially called World Wide Communion Sunday) originated in the Presbyterian Church (USA). In 1936, for the first time, the first Sunday in October was celebrated in Presbyterian churches in the United States and overseas. After a few years, the idea was welcomed by the wider Christian community as an opportunity to move beyond historical and theological differences and worship together. On this first Sunday of October, we celebrate our oneness – our communion – in Christ, in the midst of a world still in need of the reconciling unity of Christ.
